Building on the success of the many Posters presented at our 10th Anniversary Conference in 2006, we will again set aside time at the 2007 ICDL conference for Posters that celebrate the accomplishments and wide ranging reach of DIR® with illustrations of its applications in clinical, educational and training programs

We invite posters describing programs which apply DIR® principles and integrate DIR® into educational and intervention settings. These include but are not limited to early intervention, pre-school and school age educational programs (special and regular education), clinical services (diagnostic and treatment services - all disciplines), social skills and creative arts programs, parent education and support programs, research and training (in-service, interdisciplinary conferences, pre-and post service academic programs, post graduate programs, etc.). Posters can range from local to regional to international programs.

Posters will be displayed during the entire conference. Two time periods, on Friday and Saturday afternoons, have been set aside to view the posters. We ask that you plan to stand with your poster during these time periods to allow interested viewers to ask questions.

All Posters must fit on an easel or stand alone on a 6 foot table. Creating a poster is simple. As soon as you notify us of your interest, we will send you instructions with a template for creating a poster.

1. Your name and contact information, including email address, day and evening phone numbers
2. The program you wish to present
3. A brief description of your program that includes information on how you integrate the DIR® model into your program (for the conference program)
4. Please attach any descriptive materials that you feel are relevant.
